








Letter to Exhibitors: The Charlevoix Waterfront Art Fair Committee formed the Charlevoix Council for the Arts, a non-profit organization.


















Art is part of our public history, our evolving culture, and collective memories. As artists respond to our times, they portray their inner vision to the outside world, and they create a chronicle of our public experience.
