

Our Commitment

The Charlevoix Waterfront Art Fair through its tandem organization, the Charlevoix Council for the Arts (a non-profit organization), is dedicated to providing arts awareness opportunities for our children and the community of Charlevoix. These opportunities include: awarding scholarships for art and music camps, initiating education programs and workshops in our schools, hosting performances and concerts, and generally promoting and supporting overall aspects of the creative arts. We take pride in our efforts and are grateful for the many dedicated members and volunteers who make our success a reality.

Participation Rules

- Artists wishing to enter more than one medium must submit separate applications, digital images, and payment for each entry. If only one entry is accepted, work only in that medium may be exhibited.
- Only artists accepted into the Charlevoix Waterfront Art Fair will be allowed to participate. Artists must be present the entire day of the fair.
- Only artists displaying their own original work may participate. Commercial molds, patterns, kits, copies, etc., will not be accepted.
- Registration must be completed before setting up displays.
- Artist may be required to present a picture I.D. when registering.
- Only prints hand pulled and properly signed and numbered are permitted to be displayed on and in the booth. Commercial print multiples may be shown in only one flip bin, and ONLY if clearly identified as commercial prints.
- No booth or display may be dismantled or removed prior to 6:00 p.m.
- No pets allowed in park.

Because of the high demand for and limited availability of exhibit space, cancellations are a serious matter and are discouraged. Fees are non-refundable after June 15, 2023 (a \$50.00 administration fee will be deducted from all cancellations).

The CWF is a rain or shine event; plan accordingly. Only in the most extreme weather conditions, clearly hazardous to artists and their artwork, patrons and staff, will this event close down.

The committee reserves the right to make a determination on any of the above rules. It also reserves the right to accept or decline any applicant as it deems necessary and may remove all or part of an exhibit that it deems in violation of the rules.

Fees

Jury Fees: \$30.00 for application in one category, \$15.00 for each additional category

Space Fees: Each space is 10' by 10'

- 1 Space - \$225.00
- 2 Spaces - \$450.00

2023 Calendar for Artists

Feb. 15 Deadline for applications (including 3 digital images of work, plus one booth image) and jury fee.

March 1 Jury decisions will be emailed.

March 31 Upon acceptance, booth/space fee must be received in order to reserve your space.

June 15 Booth/space fees are no longer refundable (a \$50.00 administration fee will be deducted from all cancellations).

August 11 Registration, early setup 12:00 - 7:00 p.m.

NOTE: Friday night set-up is available at your own risk. The exhibit area will be patrolled with communication to the police department.
